

Idyllwild Earth Fair 2025 EXHIBITOR GUIDELINES



• Exhibitor space is approximately 10'x10' if the Exhibitor is using a canopy/easy-up, and 3'x7' if the exhibitor is using a table unless alternative arrangements are made with Earth Fair.

• Set up begins at 9:30am on Saturday. Exhibitors are to be set up from 11am and available through the end of the Fair at 5pm unless alternative arrangements are made with Earth Fair.

• Alcohol and drugs are not permitted at Earth Fair.

Print Organization/Exhibit Name

- Use of a loudspeaker or amplification is not permitted at Earth Fair.
- Exhibitors may engage visitors, discuss and hand out information at their display areas only.

• Handouts (pamphlets, flyers, coupons, etc.) are not to be left on car windshields, distributed in the parking lot, around Town Hall or at Earth Fair. Such materials may be available at exhibitor's booths.

• Exhibitors displaying and/or selling items that were not described in their application may be asked to remove those items from Earth Fair.

- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up their booth space when Earth Fair is over.
- Exhibitors assume all risks of loss or damage to their property and materials.
- Exhibitors agree to pay replacements costs of any borrowed items that are damaged or not returned.

• The Idyllwild Earth Fair Committee and Mountain Communities Fire Safe Council reserves the right to determine the suitability of any applicant to Earth Fair and to decline any application.

• Exhibitors expressly waive any and all causes of actions against the Idyllwild Earth Fair, Mountain Communities Fire Safe Council, and the San Jacinto Mountain Community Center Inc. DBA Idyllwild Town Hall for any and all claims of loss, damage, or injury to person(s) or property for any reason or causes whatsoever, per the attached release.
